

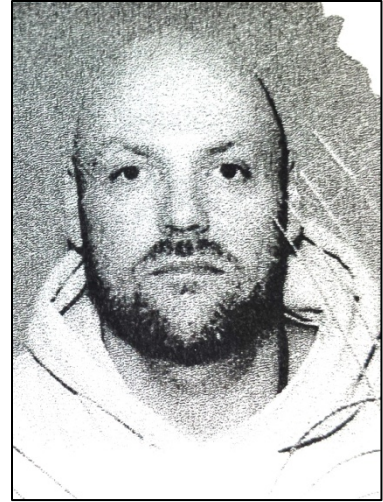
SEAN LOGSDON

Mr. Logsdon (age 44) was referred to our Harrisburg office from the Department of Corrections. He had spent the last 10 years in prison and realized he needed to learn a new set of skills that would set him on a new occupational skill path with long term benefits.



After looking over the approved training list from Southeastern Illinois College, Sean felt that the Truck Driver Training would be his best course of action with the fastest results.

Since Sean had a previous felony charge his case manager suggested he go talk with the instructor to make sure that the felony would not hinder him from getting a job. It was decided that Mr. Logsdon would be able to find employment after completing his training at the college.

Sean scored high enough on his reading test, passed his drug test and DOT physical and began the truck driving program on March 16, 2015. He passed his written permit and then on April 30, 2015 Sean received his CDL license from the State of Illinois and certificate from Southeastern Illinois College.

Since Sean is on probation he knew he would have to find a job close to home. On May 2, 2015 he started working for Southern FS Eldorado and as of November 4, 2015 is still employed with them.

The case manager first met Sean on March 9, 2015 and by May 2, 2015 he had went from unemployed and untrained to employed and trained all within 8 weeks! Sean has worked hard to turn his life around and Mid 5 wishes him much success!
